Hereby, I certify that the **Health Ministry of Mexico City**, the public government entity in charge of health coverage in the country's capital city (with an approximate population of 9,209,944 inhabitants in 2020 data, without regarding the inhabitants of its conurbated areas) has an **Integrative Medicine Program**, within its official medical care structure, integrated into our institutional regulations.

This Program consists of three public health care services, one of them being the **Clinical Phytotherapy Service**, in which patients are treated in a systematic way under the referential framework of the **endobiogenic approach**. With that purpose, our institution, in coordination with the French Society of Endobiogenic Medicine and the Mexican Society of Clinical Phytotherapy, taught, between 2009 and 2011. a training course in clinical phytotherapy to medical personnel of our institution, in a training program based on this clinical foundation and its semiological and physiological referents.

This Program, which has been operating since October 2011, provides its services through a **Specialized Center in Integrative Medicine** and a network of peripheral clinics, and its second stage of expansion is in its process of materializing, once the health contingency due to Covid-19 decrease its severity.
